ABSTRACT

This is the abstract for papers published at the COMAD conference. The style file and the sample L^AT_EX file are minor adaptations of the VLDB submission format.

1. GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

These guidelines must be read in conjunction with the information for authors.

2. FORMAT, STYLE AND CONTENT

2.1 Page size

The format of the submission should follow this sample for layout, type sizes, and other details.

2.2 Number of Pages

The paper should not extend beyond 12 pages including all references, figures and tables.

2.3 Authors

Use the `\numberofauthors` command to specify the number of authors. Each new “line” of authors should be separated by `\and`. The authors in a single line should be aligned using the `\alignauthor` command. The affiliation and email address should be placed just below the authors. Generally, try to fit 3 authors in a line.

2.4 Main Text

The paper should be in a two-column format and should use 10 pt fonts (automatically taken care of by the class file).

2.5 Tables and Figures

Tables and figures should be centered in one-column, or centered at top of page if the figure is larger than a column in width.

2.6 Copyright Notice

The class file puts copyright notice at the bottom of the first column. Please do not remove it.

3. EXAMPLE DOCUMENT

This document is an example of the recommended format and uses the *comad.cls* style file. Even if you use this document as the basis for formatting your submission, you must still check that, when printed, the hard copy meets the required format.
