

COMAD

For close to two decades COMAD – the Conference on Management of Data, modeled along the lines of ACM SIGMOD, has been the premier international database conference hosted in India. The first COMAD was held in 1989, and it has been held on a nearly annual basis since then (except for a few breaks such as in the years when VLDB and ICDE were held in India). COMAD has always had a significant international participation, with about 30% of the papers coming from outside India, including Europe, USA and East/South-East Asia.

COMAD 2009 is the 15th in the COMAD series and is being organised by the International School of Information Management (ISiM), University of Mysore, Mysore from December 9 -12, 2009 at Infosys Technologies Limited, Mysore, Karnataka, India. Similar to previous years, the scope of COMAD 2009 includes traditional database management areas as well as emergent areas like web, information retrieval and data mining.
