## Call for Abstracts for ICVGIP Doctoral Symposium

The extended abstract should clearly describe the main motivation and results with adequate details to allow the program committee to comprehend the potential contribution(s) of the work. All collated accepted abstracts will be available on the ICVGIP website. This doctoral symposium is meant for current Ph.D. students, i.e. they should be bonifide Ph.D. students during the symposium.

## Award

The best doctoral symposium paper award will be given for the best poster presentation (including the impact of the work presented) during the main conference.
