



## Map of Educational and Medical Facilities in Lanja Taluka

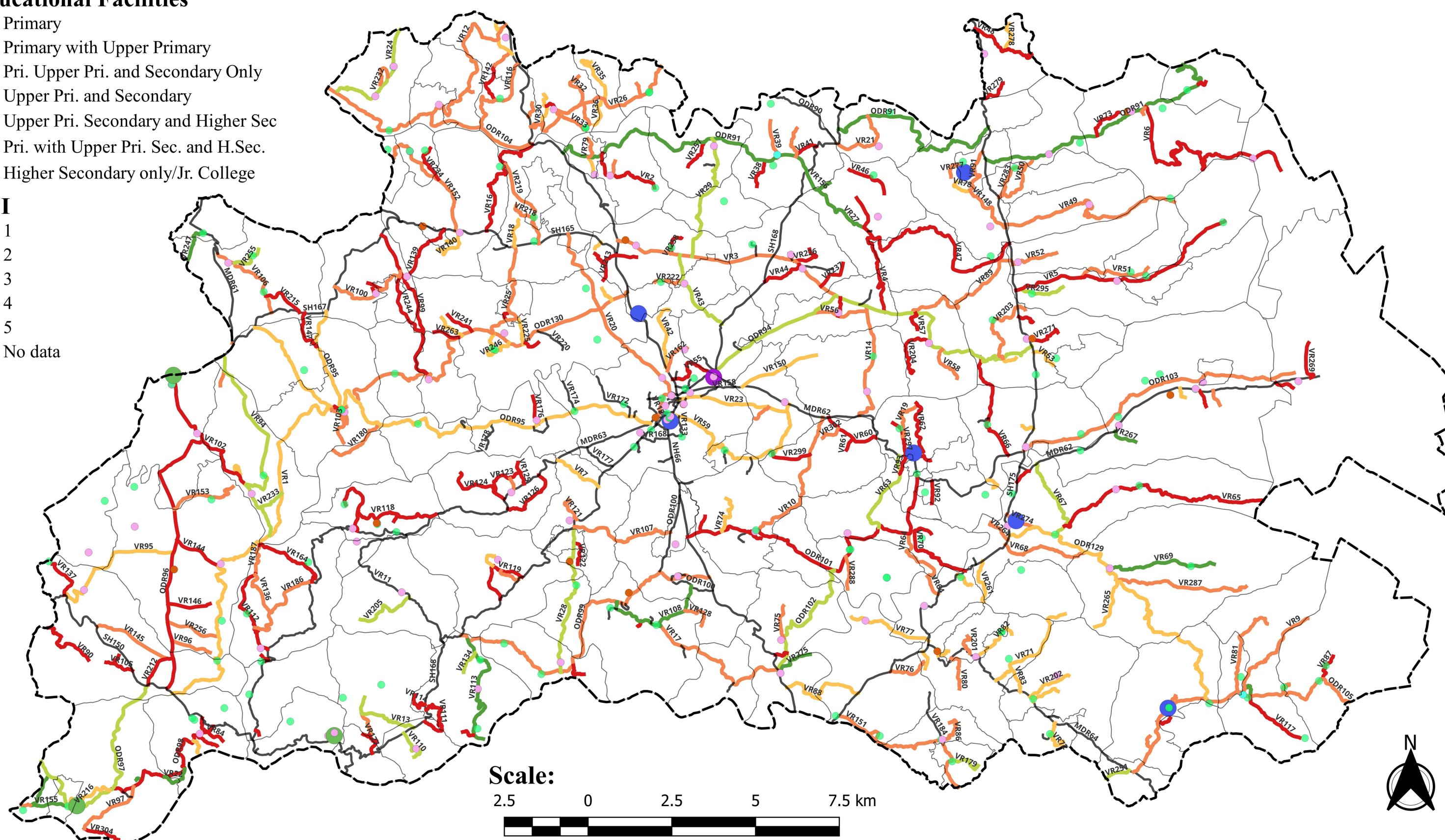

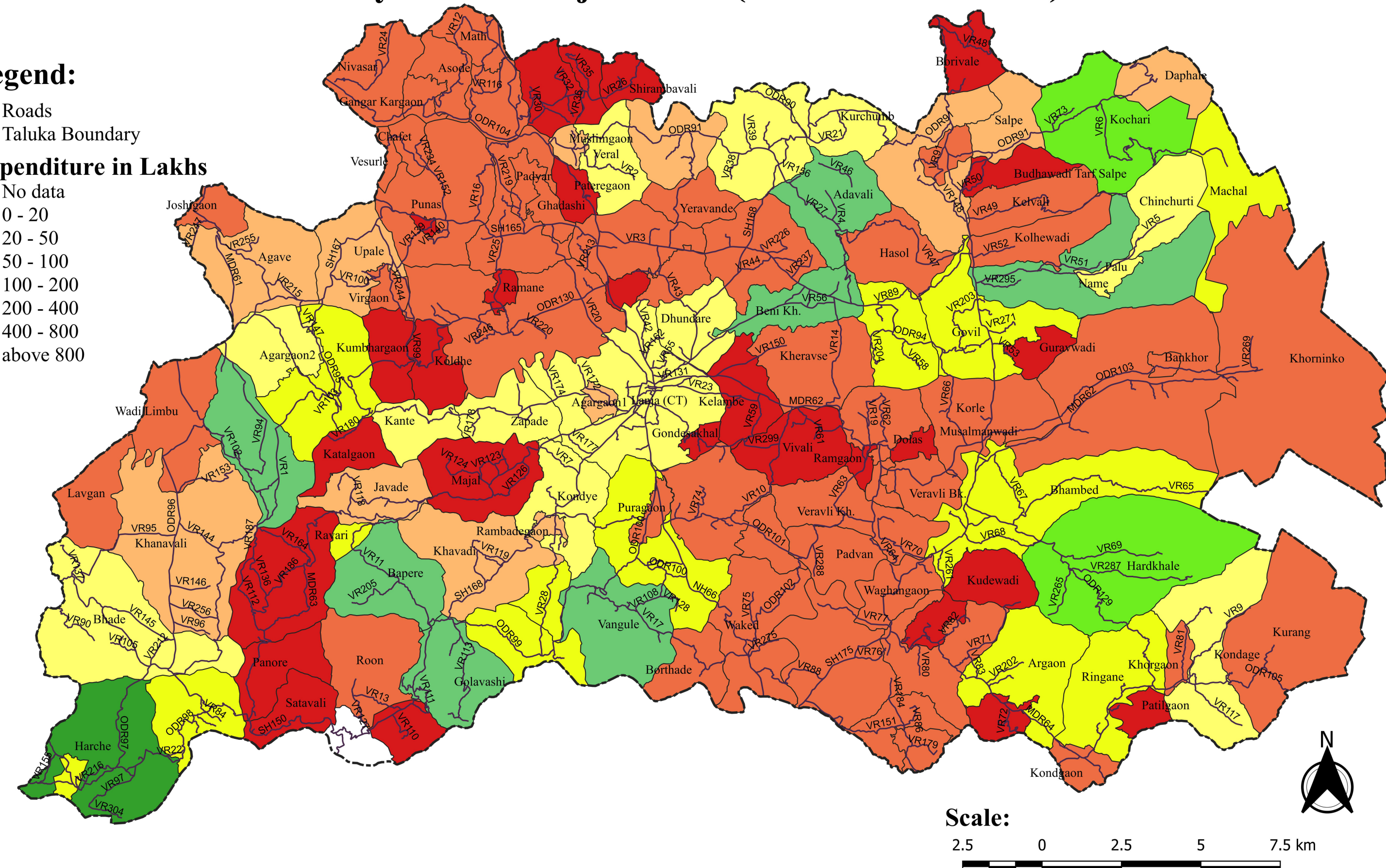
## Expenditure (in lakhs) on repairing and construction works of roads in last 5 years in Lanja taluka (2018-19 to 2022-23)

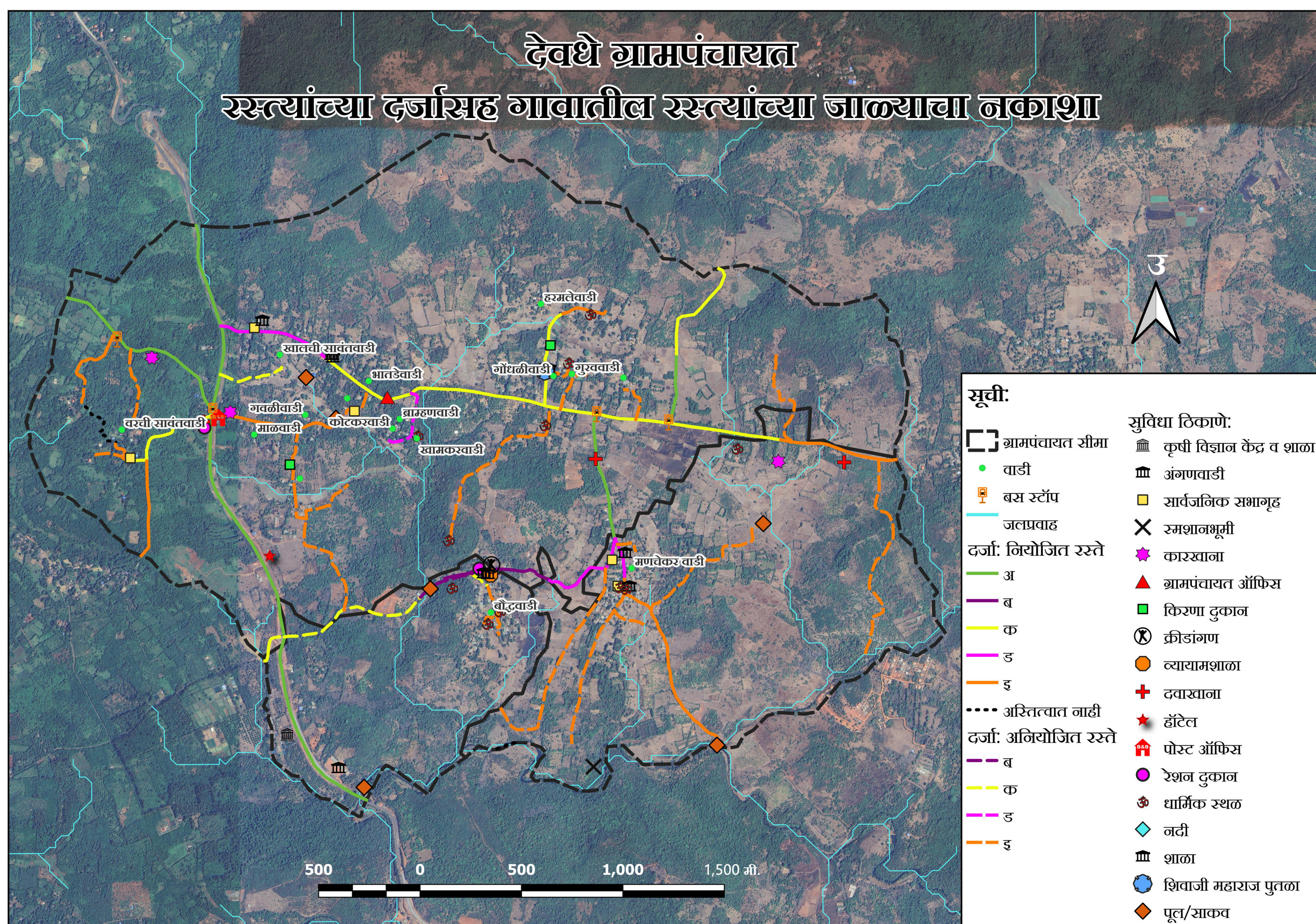

## About Lanja Taluka and its Road Network

- Around 373 kilometers of roads have undergone repair or construction work in the last five years.
- Average road coverage per year: 75 km
- Total expenditure over the past five years for road repair and construction: 73.72 Crore rupees, resulting in an average cost of 20 lakh rupees per kilometer.
- Among the 122 villages in Lanja taluka, 100 villages have undergone road repair or construction in recent years.

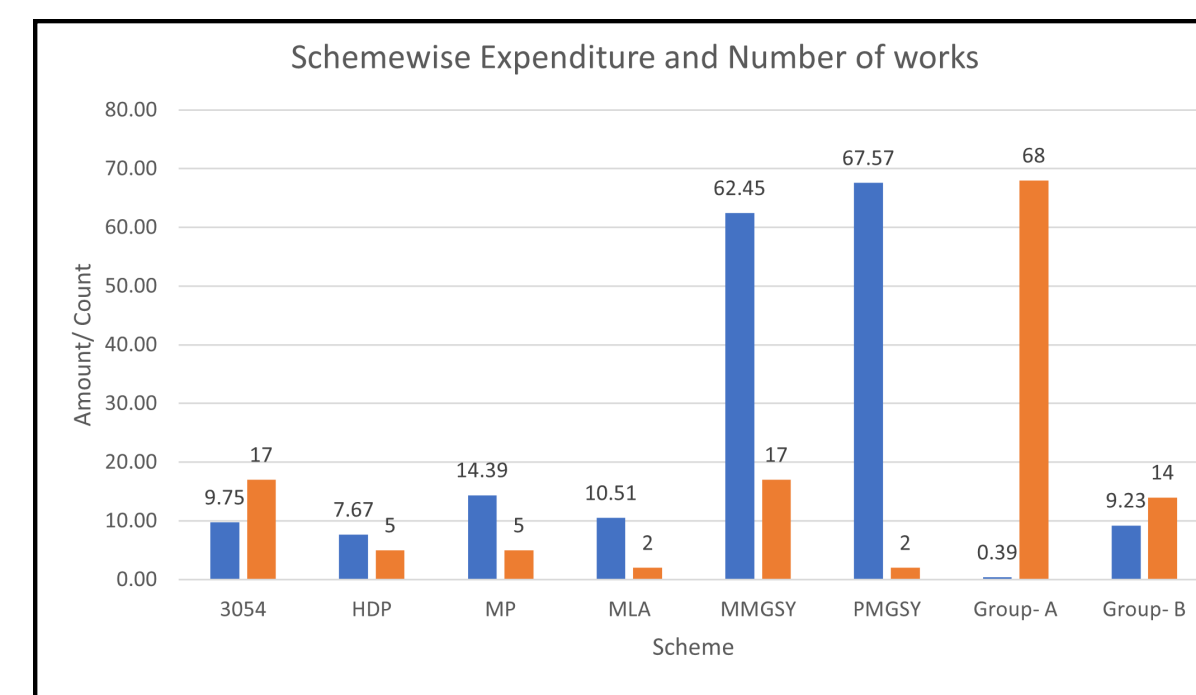
The distribution of these roads is as follows:

- National Highway: 26.41 km (1 NH)
- State Highways: 98.42 km (5 SH)
- Major District Roads: 75 km (4 MDR)
- Other District Roads: 173.41 km (16 ODR)
- Village Roads: 639.52 km (305 VR)
- Total road network span - 1013 km

## Scheme-wise expenditure and number of works



- Group-A scheme shows a high volume of road projects, with 68 projects.
- Group-A scheme exhibits the lowest expenditure per kilometer, focusing on pothole filling.
- PMGSY scheme has the highest expenditure per kilometer despite fewer projects due to new road construction and 5 year Defect Liability Period.

- Table shows the important roads in the Lanja taluka based on the available educational and medical facilities for the dependent population
- ODR91 is first in the list; there are 11 educational and medical facilities on ODR91
- Above 2000 population is dependent on ODR 91, 103, and 105 each.
