Educational Content Development


- Idea is obvious but
 - Not enough content is available!
 - 'Standard Courseware' typically targets urban scenario
 - Content is not always suitable for rural audience
- Content development can be a source of revenue
 - Developer from a village signs up on a Content Portal
 - Developer picks up a task for content creation
 - Gets paid upon task completion!


