Transportation Guide: Your Path to Amrita

- **By Air:** Fly into Coimbatore International Airport (CJB), located about 30 km from the campus. The drive takes approximately 45 minutes, and taxis are readily available
- By Train: Arrive at Coimbatore Junction Railway Station (~23 km from campus, ~60 minutes by taxi or bus), Podanur Railway Station (~20 km from campus, ~40–45 minutes by taxi or bus) that are well connected.
- Ettimadai Railway Station is approximately 500 metres from campus, so one
 may walk or take a short auto from there. Passenger trains run between
 Coimbatore Junction and Ettimadai and also from Palakkad Junction to
 Ettimadai.
- **By Bus:** Coimbatore has excellent bus connectivity. Regular bus services run from the city center to Ettimadai, near the campus.

Bus routes from Coimbatore to Ettimadai (Amrita)

From Gandhipuram (city centre)

- Buses: 96, A3, 3G run from Gandhipuram toward Ettimadai/Ettimadai Pirivu.
- Where to board: Gandhipuram Town Bus Stand / Gandhipuram Interchange.
- Where to get off: Ettimadai Pirivu (this is the common stop for most of the buses).
- Travel time: ~45–60 minutes depending on traffic.
- A3 is the most convenient some A3 services run up to the Amrita college gate (no further auto needed).

From Ukkadam

• Buses: 96, 48, S2, 3G, A3 serve Ukkadam towards Ettimadai.

- Where to board: Ukkadam Bus Stand.
- Where to get off: Ettimadai Pirivu (alight there and take an auto for the last 2– 3 km to campus)
- Travel time from Ukkadam is ~40–50 minutes. A3 may go up to the campus gate on some trips.

Specific buses & frequency

- Bus 96: Regular frequent service from Gandhipuram toward Walayar that stops at Ettimadai direction — multiple departures from early morning until evening. Good for both Gandhipuram and Ukkadam travellers. <u>Coimbatore</u> Town Bus+1
- Bus A3: Timetable examples show scheduled departures from Gandhipuram through the day (e.g., 06:15, 07:30, 08:30, 10:30, 12:25, 14:45, 17:00, 19:20, 21:40 sample list). A3 is useful because it serves Ettimadai Railway / Ettimadai Pirivu and some runs go up to the college gate. Coimbatore Town Bus+1
- Bus 3G & S2: 3G and S2 also run toward areas close to Ettimadai (3G from Ganapathy direction; S2 from Ukkadam to K.G. Chavadi direction). These are viable options depending on where you start in the city. <u>Coimbatore Town</u> <u>Bus+1</u>

Taxis / Cabs

You can reach **RedTaxi** at **0422-4567890**. They provide a range of services including local rentals, hourly rentals, and outstation trips, making it convenient for city travel as well as long-distance journeys. You can easily access RedTaxi services using their **mobile app** (available on both Android and iOS). Along with RedTaxi, other app-based cab services like **Ola** and **Uber** are also available.

Quick travel tips for participants

For Buses

- If you want a direct drop at campus gate: try to catch A3 (check with the driver/conductor whether that particular run goes up to the gate). Otherwise, alight at Ettimadai Pirivu and take an auto (~₹80-₹150 depending on time).
- Allow buffer time: City traffic in peak hours can add 10–30 minutes; plan accordingly.
- **Early/late travel:** City buses run mainly from early morning until evening for late-night arrivals prefer a taxi app or pre-booked taxi.
- Ticketing: City buses accept cash; some services may accept mobile/QR payments — keep small change for convenience.

For Trains

- **Destination stop:** Participants should get down at **Ettimadai Railway Station**, which is very close to the campus. From there, autos are usually available for the short ride to the main gate (~₹50–₹100).
- **Limited services:** Not all trains stop at Ettimadai, so check carefully on IRCTC before boarding.
- **Peak times:** Popular trains may be crowded; plan to arrive at the station a little early.
- Ticketing: Many MEMU and passenger trains issue unreserved tickets only

 best purchased at the counter (cash preferred). UTS mobile app may not always work reliably at smaller stations, so keep some cash handy.
